# REGISTRATION OF YOUR SPORT HORSE

### **American Saddlebred**

The horse must be of pure American Saddlebred blood and must qualify to its parentage by blood or DNA testing, and/or any other identification procedure deemed necessary by the Registry.

#### Fees:

Birth to 6 Months: \$45

6 Months to 12 Months: \$65

12 Months to 24 Months: \$200

Over 24 Months: \$300

#### Half-American Saddlebred

Registration in the HASRA requires one parent be a purebred American Saddlebred duly registered with the ASR. A full-blooded American Saddlebred cannot be accepted for registration as a Half-Saddlebred.

The purebred American Saddlebred Certificate of Registration must be in complete order with ASR before any offspring would be considered eligible.

Birth to 6 Months: \$35

6 Months to 12 Months: \$50

Over 12 Months: \$150
