Bred by A.E. Nelson of Santa Monica, California, My Prom Night was foaled in 1995. The elegant black mare competed in the three-gaited division and won blues at Rock Creek, Lexington Junior League and the American Royal until retiring from the show ring in her junior year. She won at the Kentucky State Fair as a three-year-old year but, due to a clerical/entry error, was disqualified. Though she may not hold a world's championship title herself, My Prom Night produced several foals that do.

The first foal of My Prom Night, The Light O'Love, (by WC sire RWC Bob Bobaloo) was also bred by A.E. Nelson. The Light O'Love earned her dam the first qualification she needed for the Broodmare Hall of Fame by virtue of her 2005 reserve world's championship win in the junior five-gaited mare stake. She was also the 2015 Junior Five-Gaited Reserve World's Champion of Champions, and in 2008, she earned the title Reserve World's Champion Amateur Five-Gaited Mare. In 2018, two offspring of The Light O'Love competed at the KSF WCHS. Say Amen was ASR Futurity of Kentucky Two-Year-Old Fine Harness World's Champion and his full sister, Dazzlelight, was the Three-Year-Old Five-Gaited World's Champion. The Light O'Love is well on her way to BHF status herself.

In 2008, Shawn Stachowski of Mantua, Ohio purchased My Prom Night. Shawn crossed her with WCC sire Mountainview's Heir To Fortune, resulting in Use Your Illusion, the 2013 Three-Gaited Three-Year-Old World's Champion - giving My Prom Night a second qualification. It took until 2018 for another of My Prom Night's offspring bred by Shawn to win the final world's championship title needed for BHF induction. Nirvana's Lithium (by Nutcracker's Nirvana) won the Three-Gaited Show Pleasure 14-17 Division I class at the Kentucky State Fair World's Championship Horse Show.

Though wins in the in hand division do not count for BHF, it is interesting to note that another of her daughters bred by A.E. Nelson, Evening (by Sky King), produced three in hand world's champions. Walterway's Everlasting Effect, Walterway's First Responder, and Walterway's Enchanted Evening, have each won world's and reserve world's championships at the Kentucky State Fair in the weanling and yearling futurities and open classes.

My Prom Night is a full sister to Three-Gaited Amateur 15.2 and Under World's Champion All Rise and to Fine Harness Junior Mare Reserve World's Champion Perdita Rose. The beautiful Perdita Rose also won a world's championship in the 1996 ASHA Amateur Two-Year-Old In Hand class.

A study of her pedigree shows that My Prom Night was destined to be a great producer. She is by the winning five-gaited stallion Periaptor, sire of

WC ^{CH}Brookhill's Periday, WC ^{CH}Brookhill's Glam Slam, etc. Broodmares by Periaptor have produced WCC ^{CH}With Style And Grace, WC Slamcracker, RWC Little Black Dress, RWC Lord Balanchine, and more. Periaptor is line bred to the ultra-game and tough RWC Wing's Fleet Admiral. Her sire line is filled with stalwart, powerful Missouri bred horses as well as the famous Texas stallion Stonewall Premier, known for passing gameness and grit to his offspring.

Her dam, Hall of Fame broodmare All Roses, was a reserve world's champion and is a product of the Ruxer Farm breeding program. Ruxer-bred through and through, the undeniably beautiful All Roses is by the prolific, multiple world's grand champion and world's champion sire Supreme Sultan and out of a daughter of WC sire Mr. Magic Man. All Roses is a full sister to several successful show horses including the stakes winner Wise And Wonderful. She herself was a successful show mare, earning her RWC title in the adult show pleasure division in 1986.

The second dam of My Prom Night is The Magic Maiden, a full sister to ^{CH}Bi Mi Rousing Cheer and a half sister to WCC ^{CH}Fancy Minikin. Her third dam, Cheers!, is a full sister to the noted three-gaited winner of her era Woodwind (dam of RWC Wind Spirit) and to WCC sire Ridgefield Heir. Her fourth dam is WC Ridgefields' Soubrette, winner of what was known in 1952 as the ASHB Two-Year-Old Fine Harness National Futurity and also RWC the same year in the ASHB Kentucky Two-Year-Old Fine Harness Futurity. Ridgefields' Soubrette is a half sister to RWC Knight's Gay Lady and to RWC Knight's Blanchette. Her fifth dam, Gay Soubrette,

is a half sister to 1929 Fine Harness RWGC Kalarama Rex (himself sire of multiple WGCs and WCs along with eight Broodmare Hall of Fame daughters), and to RWC Pirate Gold.

My Prom Night is line bred to famous sire Genius Bourbon King on her dam side. There are five different Hall of Fame broodmares in her four generation pedigree, including the mother/daughter team of noted matron Judy O'Lee and her daughter Melody O'Lee.

My Prom Night is a product of the famous "golden cross" as she has Three-Gaited WGC ^{CH}Valley View Supreme in her dam line and Five-Gaited WGC ^{CH}Wing Commander in her sire line. With two traces to the gorgeous Genius Bourbon King on her dam side, it is easy to see where My Prom Night and her offspring get their beauty and elegant way of moving, while her sire line contributes all the gameness and go-forward any horse needs. Her daughters are already proving themselves as broodmares and could very well end up in the Broodmare Hall of Fame in the future.
