31 ASR Kentucky, Kentucky Amateur and National Three- Year-Old Futurity payments due for yearlings, two-year-olds, and threeyear-olds.

#### **FEBRUARY**

**15-16** ASHA Youth Conference, Embassy Suites in Lexington, Kentucky

#### **MARCH**

- 1 ASR Three- and Four-Year- Old Sweepstakes nominations and payments due.
- 31 Pending or conditional foal applications (including DNA testing) must be completed in order to maintain ASR Futurity and Sweepstakes eligibility.

#### **APRIL**

15 ASR Kentucky. Kentucky Amateur and National Three- Year-Old Futurity stallion and mare nominations and yearling, two-year-old and three-yearold payments due if NOT paid by January 31.

#### JUNE

- 1 ASR Two-Year-Old Sweepstakes yearling nominations and two-year-old payments due. Four-Year-Old Hunter Sweepstakes nominations and payments due.
