SADDLEBRED RECORD EQUITATION CHAMPION APPLICATION RULES

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide a reference source of current and accurate information concerning the breeding records of American Saddlebred stallions and mares, to identify successful breeding combinations, to identify and honor the outstanding performers of the show ring, and to keep the history of the breed.

SADDLEBRED RECORD EQUITATION RULES

- Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible, a horse (living or deceased) must be a registered American Saddlebred and must have earned the necessary points (see Saddlebred Record Equitation Point System); applicant or owner must be a current ASHA member.
- Number of Points & USEF Show Requirements:
 To become a Champion in Equitation, a horse must have earned 15 points at United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) Licensed, USEF Lite &/or ASHA Star Shows.
- Time Limit on Points: There is no time limit on earning points.
- 4. Applications: Applications must be made on the proper form and must be accompanied by the application fee of \$75.00 and two photographs. In the case of a deceased horse, the photograph requirement may be waived if photos are unavailable. Application may be submitted by the owner, agent, or other person. A \$100 rush fee will be assessed for priority processing.
- 5. Violations of USEF Rules: If an owner or owner's
- 6. agent has been found to have been in violation of the Drugs and Medications Rules at a specific licensed horse show, no points will be earned by the horse in question for that entire horse show. Any other violations of the rules (as adjudicated by USEF) and/or correction of official show results may result in loss of points or championship status.
- 7. Approval of Champion-Equitation: When a horse has been approved as a Champion-Equitation, the applicant will receive the Certificate of Equitation Championship. The prefix CH-EQ will be permanently added to the horse's name on ASR records. If the horse has already earned a CH in performance, or subsequently earns a CH in performance, the CH-EQ will follow the CH. A new registration certificate will be issued to the Owner of Record upon presentation of the original certificate.
- **8. Permanent Status**: The designation of Champion Equitation is permanent and irrevocable, except in the case of violation of USEF rules or a correction of official show results (see Rule 5 above).
- 9. Duplicate Certificates of Equitation Championship: \$35.00 each.
- 10. Refund Policies: Refunds will be made only if (a) two or more applications have been received, or (b) at the discretion of ASR. The application with the earliest postmark will be accepted.
- 11. Exceptions: An exception may apply in the event a Championship or Finals class is changed to a stake class (ex. inclement weather) when qualifying has been waived at USEF Licensed, USEF Lite and ASHA Star Shows. Horses earning championship class points must have qualified in a prior class. (see Point Values Exceptions)

SADDLEBRED RECORD EQUITATION POINT SYSTEM

- To achieve CH-EQ status, a horse must earn a total of 15 points at USEF Licensed, USEF Lite &/or ASHA Star Shows.
- 2. Only 3 points won at ASHA Star Shows will count toward the total of 15 points required for CH-EQ status.
- 3. Only championship classes and finals count for points.
- 4. A horse that wins the Triple Crown (Senior UPHA Challenge Cup, NHS Good Hands, and USEF Medal) is automatically eligible for CH-EQ status. This may be over a horse's total show career, and can be with multiple riders.
- 5. The following classes are not eligible for points:
 - · Walk & Trot Equitation
 - · Maiden, Novice, or Limit
 - Five-Gaited Horsemanship
 - Generic equitation classes not specified as saddle seat or pleasure equitation

6. Points Values for USEF Licensed Shows

2 points 1st place Championship or Finals

class in which four or more horses have competed and qualified in a prior class.

1 point 2nd place Same as Above

7. Point Values for USEF Lite & ASHA Star Shows

1 point 1st place Championship or Finals

class in which four or more horses have competed and qualified in a prior class.

.5 point 2nd place Same as Above

In addition to the above point values, three Top Ten finishes in a final receive a combined 1 point. Eligible finals include:

- USEF Medal Finals Junior Exhibitor and Adult
- NHS Good Hands Finals
- UPHA Challenge Cup Finals Junior, Senior, and Adult
- UPHA Pleasure Equitation Finals Junior and Senior
- Saddle and Bridle Pleasure Equitation Medallion Finals
- Pleasure Equitation Olympics Junior and Senior
- ASHA National Pleasure Equitation Championship

8. Exceptions (see #11 under rules)
